

Religious Education

What does it mean for a Hindu to follow God

Children will look at Hinduism and compare it to Christianity.

We will then learn what Hindu's worship and special festivals that they celebrate.

We will also look at passages that are similar to the bible and discuss the messages within these stories.

Maths

In Year 4 we will be working on: Decimals, Money, Time, Statistics, Properties of Shape and Position and Direction.

In Year 5 and 6 we will be working on: Properties of Shape, Position and Direction, Statistics and consolidation of previous learning.

For Maths this term, Mrs Murray and Mrs Long alternate taking the two split year groups for a week of lessons. This gives ample opportunity for small group work with more contact time for each child to support and help them develop confidence in their own mathematical ability.

Literacy

This term we will be working on:

- Instructions for reading a treasure map and finding the treasure.
- Non-chronological report about the island.
- Narrative about a pirate adventure.
- Poetry about life at sea.
- Persuasive leaflet for becoming a pirate.

We will be looking at techniques such as persuasive techniques, character development, poetry features (personification, similes and metaphors) and spelling, punctuation and grammar rules.

We will use these books:

- Treasure Island by Robert Lois Stevenson
- Flotsam by David Wiesner

Art

Children will be studying boats and using research to create an accurate replica of a historical ship. Treasure maps will also be created and we will also study historical paintings of the sea.

Science

Sound – Learning about how sound is made, how we measure it and changed using the various vibrations.

Light – Learn about the way light is seen and created. Children will look at how light bends and refracts.

Changes – Children will be looking at changes of the body and life cycles. This will include looking at various other life cycles to compare.
